1. Chairman's Report – Nathan Peall

2. Treasurer's Report – Accounts & discussion of fees for next year - Ken Kirby

Accounts: The club made a loss of £490 last year,

Fritz has made the club some UWH goals which we have sold at a profit. Vote of thanks to Fritz put forward by KenG & seconded by Nathan.

We have reserves of £5k5, but we need to have quarterly pool fees ~£2k & which we have to paid in advance.

Ken has assessed the Club's finances & projected the requirements for the forthcoming year. He has allowed for the fact that we don't have any Monday night sessions until beginning of June and based his assessment on approx. 16 full paying members in the club

The club has been trying to attract new members, but this hasn't been forthcoming for the past couple of years & as such the Treasurer recommended that we increase the fees to $\pounds 40$.

The club can discuss individual requirements as necessary (this is part of our Clubmark)

Voting on Club Fees

All payment increases are due from the 1st July 2012

Proposal 1 – Just one concessionary fee:

There was a discussion on whether to have just one standard concessionary fee for the club as there appears to be several different figures that those on concessionary fees are currently paying:

Proposed by KenK to have just one concessionary fee, seconded by Nathan - Agreed - Vote carried unanimously

Proposal 2 – Agreement on the concessionary fee:

There then followed a lengthy & involved discussion on what the value of the concessionary fee should be.

Fritz proposed a single monthly concessionary fee of £28, seconded by KenG, Agreed - Vote carried unanimously

Proposal 3 – Monthly membership fees:

Main Fees discussion

Option 1 - No Change

If we don't increase it we will lose $\pm 1k$ over the next year. Our assets will cover this but it is undesirable to eat too far into our reserves.

 $Option \ 2$ - Increase standard monthly fee to £40/month

Proposed by KenK, seconded by Nathan - Agreed - Vote carried unanimously

NB - Remember that we voted last year to have a reduced fee for new members of £20 for the first six months (after the first 4 free sessions)

3. Election of Officers:

Fritz put forward a vote of thanks to the current officers for their contributions to the club.

No one else wished to stand & all three current officers were prepared to continue in their existing roles
