



XARIFA under-16 captain Joe Moss set a new goalscoring record when helping his underwater hockey team finish fourth at the Junior National Championships at Leeds International Pool.

He scored 34 goals in 10 matches on a day when only 325 were scored in 45 games across the section.

The 15-year-old from Gee Cross has been picked for Great Britain despite having only played the sport for three years.

However, his efforts were in vain as a below-strength Xarifa team could only field five players in the six-a-side event.

Although they finished equal third with Team South West, Xarifa eventually came fourth due to the number of goals conceded.

Orkney Vikings claimed top spot with Plymouth in second place.

Nevertheless, the under-13s provided the club with some good news by taking third place in their category.
